## 2009 International Service Learning Projects Summary:

- Provided a service-oriented academic experience for over 1,200 participants representing 150+ colleges and universities.
- Created Hike for Humanity program to bring medical services to remote areas.
- Launched trial project Well Child International to bring pediatric care to several special needs areas identified by local governments.
- Provided medical service for 100,000+ and dental services for 26,000+ people with little or no access to medical services in Tanzania, Costa Rica, Nicaragua, Belize, Panama, Trinidad, and Mexico.
- Provided eye exams for 25,000 and prescription and/or reading glasses for 14,000 people in remote areas.
- Distributed \$592,000+ in prescription medications to under/non served populations.
- Initiated new programs in the Dominican Republic and Peru.
- Provided medical/dental and financial support for the Ometepe Island Orphanage in Nicaragua, the Faraja Centre for Handicapped Children in Tanzania, The Lord's Home orphanage and Waite Centre for the Elderly in Belize, and many other care centers in our partner countries.
- Began expansion planning and programming for Kenya, India, Guyana, Bolivia, and Ecuador.
- Provided direct assistance and supplies for numerous churches and schools in underserved areas.
- Raised \$685,000 in financial support for mission/service projects including student sponsorships.
- Created/continued thirty full-time and seventy part-time jobs in nine foreign countries.
- Developed first High School age program of International Service Learning (Tanzania)
